I am grieving the increase in value from \$206,400 to \$210,300. This house is the sole dwelling of the owner. No part is a rental. As such, I do not agree with the increase in value, since this is no longer an income producing property. The age (1930) and the condition of the house is not of high quality. This house is located in the direct flight path of commercial and military aircraft. They literally shake the house when they fly low over it.

To further support my grievance, I have reviewed the Winooski Grand List. A good example of the discrepancy I'm seeing is the house listed as WS104 (1F DWL) which is directly across the street from me. The lot is within 0.01A of the size of mine. The house itself and the garage are bigger and in very much better condition. However, it is assessed at \$180,300.

By the City of Winooski helping me keep my taxes more reasonable, I will be able, in time, to put the money back into this house for improvements which will then increase the value.
