Background Information	In FY 2021, the City received funding through the Chittenden County Regional Planning Commission's (CCRPC) Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) to conduct a parking inventory, analysis, and management plan. The CCRPC contracted with Resource Systems Group (RSG) to complete this effort. The purpose of this plan is to provide the City with information and strategies for consideration regarding multiple aspects of parking including required minimum on-site parking in the land use regulations, management of existing on-street spaces including expansion of metered spaces, and tools to consider for future changes.
