Background Information	Pursuant to Section §19-401 of the City Charter, Chapter 28 of the City Ordinance serves to (1) provide for a fine or other penalty for violation of City ordinance; (2) regulate the rate charged for municipal water, sewer, and utility services; and (3) establish other fees. Chapter 28 of the City Ordinance, states: "Fees for Community Services and Recreation Programs not otherwise codified in this Chapter shall be determined from time to time by resolution of the City Council." The attached resolution serves to establish fees for anticipated programs within the Community Services Department which are not already established in Chapter 28 of Ordinance or by previous Council Resolution.
	Additionally, pursuant to Chapter 28 of the City Ordinance, rates for the Thrive Program shall be "Established annually by City Council Resolution". Staff are recommending maintaining the Thrive rates as spelled out in the attached resolution. Please note that these rates as proposed would go into effect for the Summer 2022 Thrive Program (currently scheduled to begin in July 2022).
