| <b>Background Information</b>                   | <p>In 2021, the City of Winooski opted in to allow retail cannabis operations in the City. While this opt-in vote was specific to retail cannabis, other cannabis operations (processors, manufacturers, laboratories, etc.) would be permitted consistent with local regulations and did not require an opt in vote. In February of 2022, the City of Winooski established a local Cannabis Control Commission to issue local licenses to any cannabis operation wishing to do business within the City.</p> <p>The City received an application for a Tier 2 Manufacturing License on April 11, 2023. The applicant had previously worked with both the Zoning Administrator and Building Code Office to ensure the necessary local permits were in place prior to application to the state. On March 27, 2023, the City received notification from the State Cannabis Control Board that a state permit would be issued pending local approval. With the state process complete, the applicant submitted the local application for approval as outlined in the October 03, 2022 memo to the Cannabis Control Commission (included for reference).</p> <p>Since this is an application for a manufacturing license, there is limited information that is considered public. This is done to protect the location and security of the operation. The applicant may offer any details they choose, but the City is limited to what can be included with the public facing component of the application.</p> |
