Overview

Under the direction of the Winooski Senior Center, Senior Center Garden Volunteers tend to the public garden/vegetable plots located at the Senior Center on 123 Barlow Street. Volunteer's plant, weed, and water the public plots for the community to enjoy. Basic gardening tools provided. Staff support is available on site during senior programming hours, Tuesday-Friday 9-2PM.

Responsibilities

- Maintain public garden/vegetable plots. Regular required maintenance may include:
 - Planting, watering, and weeding
- Assist with the end of season garden clean up
- Be compliant with city garden regulations
- Report to Senior Programs Manager

Requirements

- Must apply for the position at winooski.vt.gov/volunteer or contact the Volunteer Coordinator
- Meet with Senior Programs Manager for an info session
- Comfortable leaning over or sitting on the ground
- Gardening Experience—Helpful but not required
